Munster Board of Safety Meeting Minutes
Thursday, February 15, 2024
7:00 a.m.
Munster Town Hall Main Meeting Room

This meeting was held in person at the Munster Town Hall and via Zoom.

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Town Attorney David Westland at 7:07 a.m. Board of Safety members present: Jerry Baffa, Dr. Robert Dershewitz, Linda Dunn, Matt Maloney, and Dr. Lorin Brown via cell phone to listen only because an approved Zoom address was not able to be established by IT and therefore he was not allowed to speak.

Others present: Chief of Police Stephen Scheckel, Lieutenant Daymon Johnston, Administrative Assistant to the Chief of Police Nancy Nadratowski, Fire Chief Mark Hajduk, Duty Fire Chief Dave Strbjak, Lieutenant Joe Lash, Town Council Members Dave Nellans, George Shinkan and Chuck Gardiner, Town Attorney David Westland, Clerk Treasurer Wendy Mis, Clerk Treasurer Personnel Patricia Abbott, Superior Ambulance Personnel Jeff Collins, Dave Faber, Jan Cox, and Armani Porter.

Mr. Westland stated that due to Chairman Brown not being in attendance or via Zoom and former Vice Chairman Mike Clark no longer a member, the Board will need to appoint a Vice Chairman.

Dr. Dershewitz motioned to nominate Jerry Baffa as Vice Chairman of the Board of Safety. Ms. Dunn seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 4-0. The meeting was turned over to Vice Chairman Jerry Baffa.

Pledge of Allegiance

Public Comment: There was no public comment.

Dr. Dershewitz asked for clarification regarding the decrease in inspections in November 2023 compared to November 2022. Chief Hajduk explained that inspections are done on an annual basis, unannounced, and if there were less violations there would be less follow up inspections. Also, the inspector was on vacation in November 2023.

Mr. Maloney motioned to accept the Consent Agenda items. Dr. Dershewitz seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 4-0.

III. Items for Action & Discussion

A. Superior Ambulance Reports for November & December 2023, January 2024

Ms. Dunn stated the last few months have been good and therefore motioned to accept the Superior Ambulance Reports. Mr. Maloney seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 4-0.

IV. Fire Chief's Report

Chief Hajduk stated it has been quiet, though during the cold spell they had members sleeping at the station. They are working on getting the pickup outfitted. The department has also ordered new portable radios similar to the Police Department's.

V. Police Chief's Report

Chief Scheckel explained Administrative Special Order #23-05 was removing Officer Shane Gomez from Probationary status to 2nd Class Patrolman. The Memorandum of Understanding with Superior Ambulance was enclosed for the Board's review. This allows Superior Ambulance to transport and provide Advanced Life Saving care to the department's K-9's if injured in the line of duty. Mr. Westland said they reviewed the MOU previously and the only change from the last version is a \$900.00 charge per incident.

Mr. Maloney motioned to accept the Memorandum of Understanding with Superior Ambulance and have it presented to the Town Council at their next meeting. Dr. Dershowitz seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 4-0.

Every two years the list of Tow Service Providers needs to be evaluated and approved. Lt. Johnston has reviewed the list and has not found any issues with the current providers. His recommendation is to approve the list which will be good for 2024 to 2026.

Mr. Maloney motioned to accept the list of Tow Servicer Providers. Ms. Dunn seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 4-0.

The Police Department is looking for a recommendation from the Board of Safety to implement a Take Home Squad Program. This would align the department with other municipalities throughout Lake County. In the long run it will save the department because squads will not be used 24/7 like they are now, which requires more maintenance and replacement every two (2) years. Officers would be responsible for their own vehicle versus a pool car that is used by many. In order to move this item forward to the Town Council the Board's approval and support is needed.

Ms. Dunn asked if this had been budgeted? Chief Scheckel stated the Town Council and Clerk Treasurer will work on identifying a funding source. Mr. Maloney asked what would happen to the current vehicle stipend? Chief Scheckel stated it would be phased out or rolled into salaries. That is a decision for the Council to make. Mr. Maloney asked if this will help in retention and recruitment? Chief Scheckel said it would, especially with younger officers coming on. Most departments in Lake County do it and that is who we are competing with. The FOP initially asked to go to this program. The Board is not committing anything just moving the matter up to the Town

Council. Dr. Dershewitz asked for a ballpark figure. Chief Scheckel stated we are looking at twenty (20) squads at about \$38,000.00 per squad and approximately the same amount in equipment per squad.

Mr. Maloney motioned to approve the Police Department's recommendation of the Take Home Squad Program and send it on to the Town Council for review. At this time Vice Chairman Baffa turned the gavel and meeting over to Ms. Dunn. Mr. Baffa seconded the motion.

Town Council Liaison George Shinkan stated one of the issues our town faces is hiring quality officers as our town is probably one of the third lowest paid. We are losing good officers to other departments due to pay and take home cars. We should be providing public safety with the best we can.

Town Council President David Nellans asked to address the Board in support of this matter. He stated we are doing this to stay competitive in the market and get more squads on the street and seen within town. He is asking the Board to consider and support it and move it forward up to the Council.

Dr. Dershewitz said he would be happy to support the issue being that the funds are not taken away from another program. Ms. Dunn added this is the first she has heard of this, though is not opposed to it. Town Council President Nellans apologized and said he and Mr. Shinkan have been in discussions with the FOP and the Chief of Police and are bringing it to the Board now for recommendation.

Mr. Westland stated the Council has the authority to implement this policy on its own. Historically the Council has leaned on the Board to give its blessing, or non-blessing, to such matters. The Council will work with the Clerk Treasurer from a financial standpoint and then with the Chief regarding the policy.

Mr. Maloney asked which towns surrounding us have this program? Chief Scheckel stated most of them, including Schererville, Highland, Crown Point, Lake County, Griffith, and Dyer. It has been a long time in the making. The stipend was acceptable initially though take home squads seem to be a draw with applicants.

All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 4-0.

Ms. Dunn returned the gavel, and the meeting was turned back over to Vice Chairman Baffa.

IX. Adjournment

Dr. Dershewitz motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Maloney seconded the motion. All members present voted aye, motion approved 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:42 a.m.



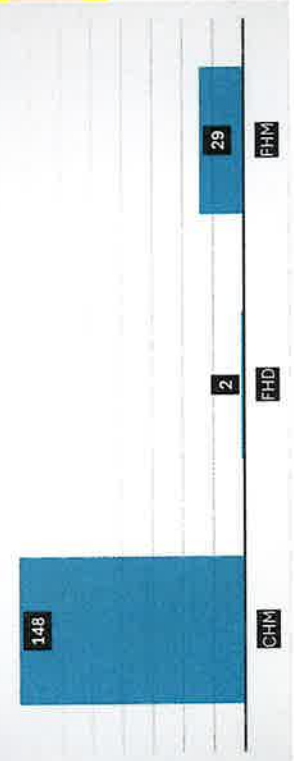

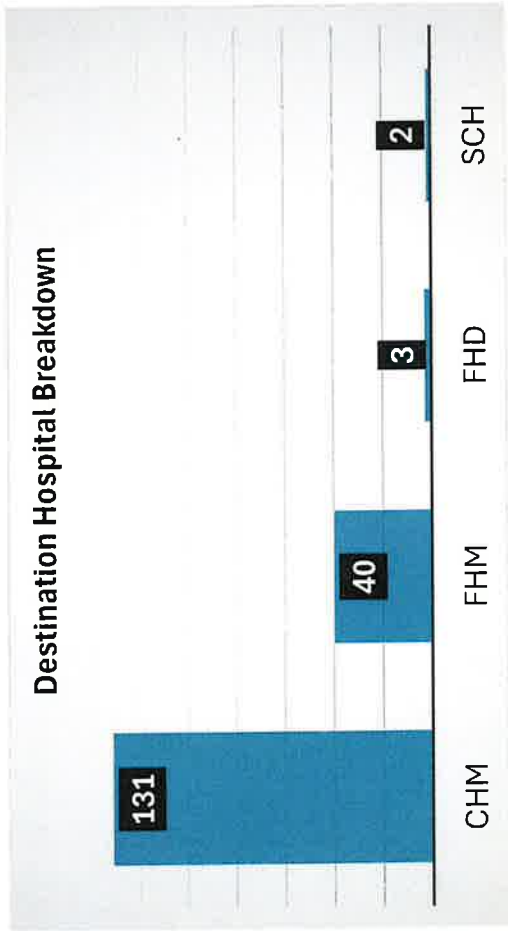
