FROZEN PIPES AFTER HOURS

In the event of a water emergency, such as water meter freezing, immediate assistance is crucial. If the situation occurs after the water billing clerks' operating hours (Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 4:30 pm), please call 911 for help, as messages



left after hours will only be addressed on the next business day morning.

REMOVING SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS

It is especially important for residents to remember the Town of Munster's ordinance in regard to removing snow and ice from sidewalks. For everyone's safety, please follow this ordinance:

The owner and/or occupant of any dwelling, building or subdivided lot or property shall keep the sidewalks in front thereof clean at all times of the year. Within 24 hours after any fall of snow or formation of ice, such snow or ice shall be removed from the sidewalks.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, push or deposit in any manner snow, slush or ice onto any street or sidewalk in such a manner as to impede the safe progress and movement of vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
